

Rider Education

The difference between a minor injury and a major one can be matter of a few millimeters of safety gear.

I've talked about the importance of safety wear and on a hot summer day it can get very uncomfortable to wear. Last week I was taking a short ride to the local eatery for lunch with friends and it was hot and humid I felt I was going to melt. I thought to myself forget the jacket and boots just throw on a t-shirt, sneakers and go. But I remembered most accidents happen within 25 miles of your home so I put on all my riding gear and went off to a uneventful lunch. The next week after lunch I was headed home in my car this time and noticed blue lights at the intersection near my house. There was a car with heavy damage to the front left side. I the saw a group of people with looks of horror on they're faces looking down at something. I finally got to a point where I could see what they where looking at, it was a young man who I have seen on several occasions on my street riding with no helmet, in shorts a t-shirt and flip flops. He was writhing around on the ground in pain with areas of large road rash, trying to get up then falling back to the ground, out of the group of people one woman was trying help the young man a few feet away lay his motorcycle damaged from where he had hit the car. I would think had he been wearing protective riding gear his injuries would have been less severe. The main point of this story is to stress the importance of wearing your gear all the time because accidents don't give warnings they are going to happen.

P.S. When is the last time you checked your oil, radiator fluid, tire pressure, tire tread, brake and signal lights.
