

Hello Everyone, We had a Road Captains Course on Aug. 23rd., so we have a new group of 13 freshly trained ride leaders and tail gunners. Tommy Martin did great presentation and we had on the road practice. If you want to sharpen your skills or refresh skills. Consider going to the classes that are offered thru GWRRA. Have you ever seen a road gator or know what one is? Well the truth is they are the rubber treads that have peeled off of tires, usually tractor trailers and they are a very dangerous road hazard. If you hit one it can cause you to lose your balance and down you go. If it wraps around your wheels it can cause loss of control of you motorcycle, damage to wheels and under carriage. Also did you know that Tractor trailer tire can blow out with enough force to injure you the rider. I recently read a story about two motorcycle riders who had this happen to them luckily no crash but one of them got some nasty bruises from the shreds of rubber from the tire. So when passing a tractor trailer get around it as quickly and safely as you can.
