


# **Rider Education**

If you have a Goldwing 1500 or earlier model you have a timing belt instead of a timing chain. This belt needs to be replaced in order to avoid major engine damage. For those of you have the tools, time and skill this is a 1 day project. Most belts should be changed every 50,000 miles or after a bike has been sitting for several years. Even though the belt may look good, due to extremes of weather and oxidation the belt will deteriorate, become brittle and break without warning. 


## CHAPTER VISITATION AND PICNIC
