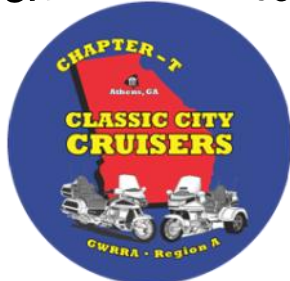

RECIPE of the Month



Italian Crème Layer Cake

- 1 Stick of butter
- 2 Cups of Sugar
- 5 Eggs separated
- 2 cups of plain flour
- 1 cup of butter milk
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1/2 cup of vegetable oil
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 7oz can coconut
- 1 cup of chopped pecans

Mix butter, Sugar and egg yokes, add flour, butter milk, oil, soda and vanilla. Fold in coconut, nuts and beaten egg whites. Bake at 350 for 20 - 25 minutes. Cool.

FROSTING

Blend 1-8 oz cream cheese, 1- stick of butter and 1- tsp of vanilla. Gradually add 1 box of powdered sugar and 1 cup of nuts

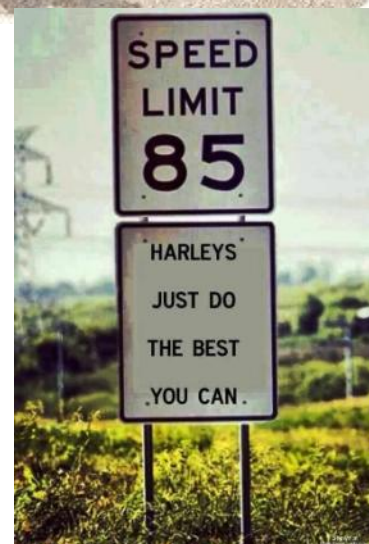
