

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Rider Education

How To Improve Your Chances Of Being Accident Free.

What separates a average motorcycle rider and being a safe motorcycle rider? Why does one rider wreck and and another have many years of accident free riding ? Is it luck, fate or karma? The answer is lack of proper training and education. The National Highway Safety Administration lists the following as causes for motorcycle crashes.

- lack of basic riding skills
- failure to appreciate the inherent operating characteristics
- failure to appreciate the limitations of the motorcycle
- failure to use special precautions while riding
- failure to use defensive driving techniques.
- lack of specific braking and corner skills
- failure to follow speed limit

As a member of G.W.R.R.A. you have the opportunity to take education and training classes that will give you the edge to be a safe rider and avoid accidents. G.W.R.R.A. offers classes from basis riding skills to advanced. Look for training classes being held near you through your local chapter and district news letters.

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Tips to Toes!!

My article starts with a pun and that being with the word Tips. The message it is relating to is the tip to be warm from the tip of you head to the bottom of your toes. This information will not necessarily keep you warm, but it might help you in deciding how much and how many layers you might need to wear. The co-rider tends to take on much more wind than the rider because they are not as protected by the windshield. I wish I would have known about the chart I am going to share with you when we first started riding and way before Gerbing. Tommy and I were on a ride up near Virginia, I don't really remember why or where we were going but I do remember that it was cool and turning colder. Every morning I would check the temperature and try to decide how many layers of clothes I would need to put on. After several tries I decided for me that anything under 60' was a three layer day. I have learned a lot in the 16 years that I have been riding and one of the main things is to be as comfortable as you can be with the knowledge you have. I hope this information will help you when your on a ride and the weather turns a little cool. Or you can try what I did and buy some Gerbing heated gear which works GREAT!
