

## **Rider Education**

Have you ever had a friend tell you that riding a motorcycle is one the most dangerous things you can do. They may be surprised that some of their own behaviors are far more dangerous. Here are 13 behaviors you may refresh them on.

1. Alcohol: 25,692 people were killed in the U.S. by alcohol poisoning in 2010. (Source: CDC

2. Smoking: 440,000 people in the U.S. are killed each year due to tobacco-related illnesses. (Source: CDC)

3. The Flu: 48,614 Americans were killed by the flu during the 2003-04 season. (Source: CDC

**4. Texting:** NHTSA estimates that 24 percent of crashes involved drivers talking or texting on cell phones. That's 7,247 deaths caused by phone use in 2010 alone. (Source: NSC)

5. Falling Down: 25,000 people die each year due to simple falls. (Source: NSC

6. Poison: 39,000 people are killed each year due to household poisons and prescription medication. (Source: NSC)

7. Second-Hand Smoke: 49,000 people in the U.S. die each year due to inhaling second-hand smoke. (Source: CDC)

8. Getting Shot: Guns kill 31,940 people in the U.S. each year. The vast majority of which are suicides. (Source: CDC)

9. Healthcare: As many as 98,000 Americans are killed each year by, "preventable medical errors in hospitals." (Source: NAP)

10. Having Sex: 20,000 Americans are killed each year by sexually transmitted infections. (Source: CSDP)

11. Getting High: 17,000 Americans die each year due to drug abuse. (Source: <u>CSDP</u>)

12. Being Fat: 400,000 Americans die each year due to, "Poor diet and physical inactivity." (Source: CSDP)

13. Your Bathroom: Nearly 9,000 Americans were killed by their bathrooms in 1999. (Source: LA Times)

For the same year of this study <u>4,957 motorcyclists were killed</u>. So, yes motorcycle riding is dangerous but chances are one of the 13 other dangers will get you first.

## **Cheesy Chicken Croissants**

June, 2015

- 1 Can Cream of mushroom soup
- 1 8 ct crescent rolls
- 1 9.75 oz can of white chunk chicken breast
- 2 Cups shredded sharp chatter cheese

Place drained Chicken in a bowl, combine chicken and 1 cup of cheese together. Spray 8 x 8 pan with cooking oil. Separate crescent and open rolls, place 1-2 Tsp of chicken and cheese mixture on each roll. Roll up and place in sprayed pan. Sprinkle leftover mixture over the top of rolls. Mix mushroom soup and 2/3 cup of water and pour over croissants. Sprinkle with remaining cheese and bake at 375 until golden brown approx. 20-30 minutes

Sometimes served with rice on the side.
