

Recipes

This apple cake is not only delicious, it's easy to make. Grease and flour a tube cake pan and pre-heat oven to 350 degrees.

Fresh Apple Cake

- 3 eggs
- 1 1/4 cup oil
- 2 cups sugar
- 2 1/2 cups self-rising flour
- 2 medium apples, peeled, cored and chopped
- 1 cup shredded coconut
- 1 cup chopped walnuts or pecans
- 1 tsp. cinnamon



Blend eggs, oil and sugar until creamy. Add flour a little at a time. Blend well. Batter will be stiff. Fold in apples, coconut and nuts. Pour into tube pan and bake for 1 hour. Remove from pan after about 30 minutes.

Top warm cake with the following:

- 1/2 stick butter
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/3 cup milk

Mix butter, sugar and milk in saucepan. Boil for 3 minutes, pour over warm cake.

What is GWRRA Rider Education?

We have been ask this question many times. The GWRRA Rider Education Program (REP) is intended to make the motorcycle environment safer by reducing injuries and fatalities and increasing motorcyclist skills and awareness. The REP does not propose to have all the answers. However, our close-working relationship with the Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF), as well as additional GWRRA programs and studies, has provided a wealth of information for use in establishing a comprehensive Rider Education Program. Through Commitment, Education and Application, we can reduce our accident rate significantly. There are 4 achievable levels in the Rider Education Program.

Level I: Safety by Commitment - The first big step to success

Level II: Safety by Education

Level III: Safety by Preparedness

Level IV: Safety By Enhanced Commitment and Preparedness

Level IV is the most prestigious of the REP levels and is referred to as Master Tour Rider/Co-Rider

Rider Education offers several Seminars and Rider Courses that help us reach each level in the program. These seminars and rider courses are offer through the year at the chapter level and also at most GWRRA Rallies and events. The most important thing to remember is if you attend a seminar or riding course document it and provide your Chapter Educator with a copy of the information. There are forms that must be filled out and sent to the District Educator to move from one level to the next. As your Chapter Educator I can help you get those forms filled out and placed in the right hands to make sure that you are current in the levels program. If you have any question about the rider Education Program please don't hesitate to ask, we are here to help.


