

Team / Group Riding

The Gold Wing Road Riders Association is a touring motorcycle organization comprised of people from all walks of life that share the common interest of riding a Honda Gold Wing or Valkyrie. The Team Riding seminar and guidelines was developed to help those who enjoy riding in a group plan for a safe ride together. Whether it is a first time adventure, a weekend trip, or a short distance to a favorite ice cream parlor, this guidelines are geared to aid in maintaining a safe and enjoyable motorcycle group ride.

The fun, pleasure, and the enjoyment of riding your motorcycle in a group with other GWRRA friends is an important part of what GWRRA is all about. It's also exciting! If you have never ridden with a group before, these techniques will help you become comfortable with team riding. However, any kind of team riding is very different from individual riding. Whether you ride as an individual or in a group, in order to survive on the open road, your motorcycle riding habits and techniques must be constantly thought of as "defensive". When you ride in a group, your actions not only affect you, but the other riders as well. Therefore, it is important to recognize and remember that riding in a group is a "TEAM" effort. To be safe, you must rely on the cooperation and coordination of all riders in that group. If you are new to this form of riding, studying the techniques before your first group ride will help you understand and become more comfortable as a team member in the group. You will find that a team ride can be most enjoyable.

There are several areas that we need to cover in the team riding area such as preparation for the ride, conduct during the ride, etc. We will be talking more about Team Riding at the gathering and hope to be holding a Team Riding seminar soon. Hey we like to eat and ride so I propose a Dinner and a Seminar at one of our meet and eats. Nothing like getting together, EATING and Socializing, plus getting a little Rider Safety Education to boot!

Remember the Rider Education Motto: Safety is for Life!

North Carolina Launches "Obey the Sign or Pay the Fine"


Attention all riders who may be traveling to or through North Carolina in the next few weeks. Police are currently issuing citations for even minor speeding violations. Members of this list have reported observing numerous motor vehicles pulled over along North Carolina roads. The effort is being called "Obey the Sign or Pay the Fine." Any speeding violation may result in a traffic citation. The following was taken from a press release issued by the North Carolina Department of Transportation:

Obey the Sign or Pay the Fine Enforcement Blitz Launched

Last year, speeding was a contributing factor in 23 percent of all fatal crashes in North Carolina, and 322 people died as a result of these crashes. To reduce these fatalities, the Governor's Highway Safety Program, along with state and local law enforcement agencies, launched a speed enforcement campaign on March 24, called Obey the Sign or Pay the Fine to remind motorists that the posted speed limit is the law. The enforcement blitz runs through April 3.

If you find yourself traveling to or through North Carolina in the next few weeks it would be advisable to strictly adhere to the posted speed limit.
