Rider Education

We just arrived home from a long trip out west and we had a great time. We traveled in and out of 18 states in 17 days. Needless to say we encountered just about any type of riding conditions you could imagine. Whether it be traffic, terrain or weather conditions. We are thankful that we made it back home safe and sound.

Fortunately Vicky and I have taken many of the Rider Education classes and do our best to stay current and keep our skill fresh. We believe that our safety skills have saved us several times. One time on this particular trip was while riding through Yellow Stone National Park viewing the herds of buffalo's, all of a sudden from the sky came a hail storm lasting about three minutes, the hail was about dime to quarter size and covered the ground with more than an inch ice. Our training kicked in, there was constant communication between rider and co-rider, the Co-Rider and slow ride training paid off (Remember - head up, look Straight Ahead, increase RPMs, cover the Rear Brake, Stay Calm and we become one with the bike, good communication between Rider and Co-rider.) Staying sharp on your riding skills is very important. Practice together and be prepared. As my good friend Chuck Reed says "Always expect the unexpected"!
