## **RECIPES**

## **PIZZA SAUCE**

1 – 32 OUNCE CAN WHOLE OR DICED TOMATOES 6-8 GARLIC CLOVES 2 TEASPOONS BALSAMIC VINEGAR SALT PEPPER OLIVE OIL

### "DO NOT COOK SAUCE"

COMBINE TOMATOES, GARLIC, VINEGAR, ½ TSP. SALT, SOME BLACK PEPPER AND A DRIZZLE OF OLOVE OIL IN A BLENDER.

Hint: You can use tomatoes and juice or drain off the juice for a more concentrated sauce.

Puree sauce, taste and adjust as need with salt, pepper and olive oil.

This recipe makes enough sauce for 8 pizzas.

Pour leftover sauce into muffin tins and freeze. When frozen remove from tin and store in freezer bag. Must thaw before use....do not cook.


