









We had to cancel the weekday ride on May 23rd due to heavy rain. We will reschedule the weekday ride.



Hi All,

It is summer time and the heat and humidity has arrived with the summer thunder storms. Please remember to stay hydrated when riding. Start the day before when planning a long ride in the heat. Drink more Water and Gatorade instead of soda's, cokes, tea, coffee, etc. Take breaks often and cool down in an air condition building or underneath shade trees. Be alert and keep an eye on your Rider, Co-Rider and Friends that you ride with for signs for heat exhaustion which could lead to heat stroke.

The most common signs and symptoms of heat exhaustion include:

- Confusion.
- Dark-colored urine (a sign of dehydration)
- Dizziness.
- Fainting.
- Fatigue.
- Headache.
- Muscle or abdominal cramps. Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.

RECIPES

Bruschetta Chicken Pasta Salad

Serves 8

Ingredients:

- 1 lb Thin Spaghetti Pasta
- 1 lb Skinless boneless chicken breast
- 2 tbsp Italian seasoning
- 1 tsp garlic powder
- salt and pepper, to taste
- 1/4 c Olive Oil
- 2 tbsp minced garlic
- 2 tbsp red onion
- 2 tbsp Balsamic Vinegar
- 2 tbsp finely chopped basil
- 8 ea Roma Tomatoes, chopped
- 1/2 c grated Parmesan cheese, plus more to serve

Balsamic Glaze to serve



Instructions:

- 1. Cook Pasta according to package directions Drain and rinse with cold water. Transfer to a large bowl and set aside
- 2. While the pasta is boiling, combine the Italian Seasoning, Garlic Powder, Salt & Pepper in a shallow bowl.
- 3. Season Chicken on both sides.
- 4. Heat 1 Tablespoon of oil in a grill pan or skillet. Sear chicken breasts over medium heat on both sides until browned and cooked through about 6 minutes per side. Remove from pan and set aside
- 5. Add olive oil to the same hot pan, saute the garlic & red onion until the garlic is fragrant about 1 (one) minute.
- 6. Turn off heat, add tomatoes, toss the them lightly and add the mixture onto the pasta.
- 7. Slice the chicken and add to the pasta, tossing well.
- 8. Add vinegar, Parmesan cheese and basil, toss the pasta with all the ingrediants until well combined.
- 9. Top with 2 tablespoons of the extra parmesan and serve immediately with the balsamic glaze. Or, refrigerate up to an hour an before serving.
