Zucchini Bread

3 eggs. 1 cup vegetable oil. 2 cups sugar

2 cups plain flour 1/2 t baking powder.

1 1/2 t baking soda. 2 t cinnamon. 1 t salt

3 t vanilla. 1 cup chopped nuts. 2 cups grated zucchini

Beat eggs oil and sugar together. Sift flour baking powder soda salt and cinnamon together mix with wet ingredients. Add vanilla nuts zucchini Grease 2 loaf pans bake at 350*. For 45 minutes to 1 hour. Enjoy!!!!
