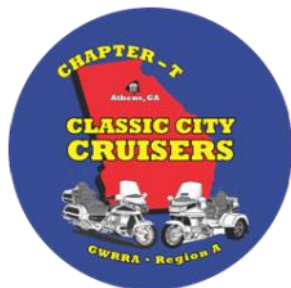

Chapter Meet & Eat

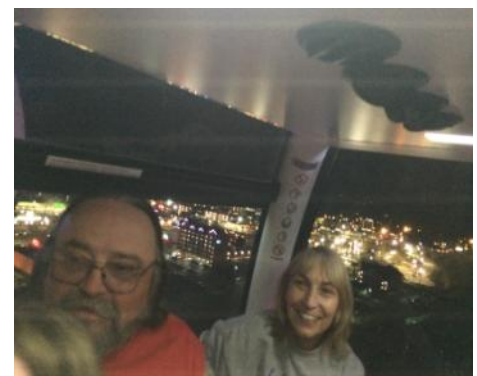
Chapter T members gathered at Pamendis for a meet and eat on April 10th which also served as the April monthly gathering. FUN was had by all!

BBQ Ranch Pasta Salad Ingredients:

1 pasta, (I used cavatappi, cooked until al dente)
1 cup Hidden Valley® Honey BBQ Dressing
1/3 cup sour cream
1 can black beans, (rinsed and drained)
1 cup canned corn, (drained)
1/2 red bell pepper, (diced)
1/2 small red onion, (finely diced)
1 1/2 cups diced cooked chicken
1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
2 tablespoons chopped fresh cilantro
1 cup corn chips

Directions:

1. Place cooked pasta in a large bowl.

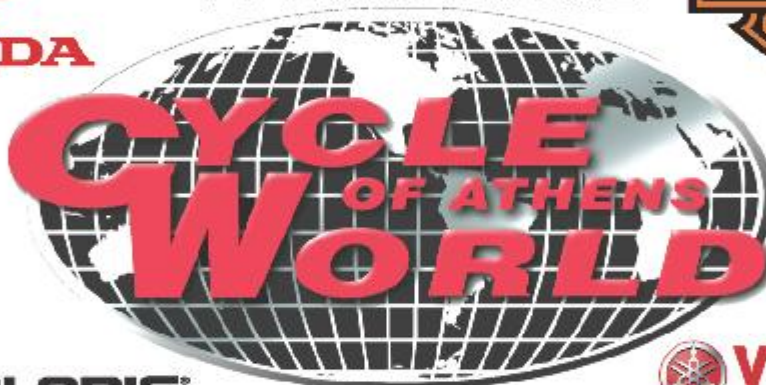
