Chapter T friends, by the time we have our meeting in July we will have been on our bucket list road trip 83 days, and the odometers have exceeded 7000 miles. America is so beautiful, we continue to be overwhelmed with its beauty.

When we left Los Angeles, we rode the Pacific Coast Highway, then onto the Grapevine (I-5N Freeway) heading to Visalia, CA for a couple of days. The Tail of the Dragon has nothing on the road going up to the Sequoia National Park. There were several 8% inclines, and had to stop several times as both trikes ran hot. It helped that there was two thirty minute stops due to road construction. When we finally made it to the park, it was an AWESOME sight.

From there we went to Oakhurst, CA for three days. We decided to give the trikes a rest and rode the bus to Yosemite National Park. Another AWESOME wonder -- we got teary eyed and all we could think of was the song, "How Great thou Art".

We then rode to Redding, CA, with plans to spend just a couple of days but stayed longer as Jim developed a UTI. The ride to the emergency is a story that can only be told in person. We left CA and rode to Grants Pass, OR. It was a long, hot ride, so we spent an extra day there. We then rode up the Oregon coast, through several mountain ranges where we were taken back by the tall Redwoods. We spent the night in Astoria, OR. From our hotel we could see this very high and long bridge that would have required us to cross to get into WA. We chose to go back thru Portland, a longer ride but more scenic and besides who would want to cross a bridge on a hot windy day

On our ride to Seattle, WA we thought we were in the middle of Atlanta traffic as we encountered several traffic jams about twenty miles before we got to our hotel. Seattle drivers are as just as "friendly" as Atlanta drivers. Need we say more? It was a hot Sunday afternoon and we did not want to encounter Seattle's "friendly" drivers again, so we rode the monorail to Pikes Market, which by the way is another "check" on our bucket list. The day at Pikes Market ended with lunch by the water.

We left Seattle and rode to Post Falls, Idaho for the night. The next day we had a beautiful scenic ride through mountains of Montana. More rain was forecasted then predicted and we tried to extend our stay and were told that because of state wide soccer tournaments all rooms were booked at this particular hotel. We were successful in finding other accommodations for extra days.

2 eggs

1 cup buttermilk

4 T melted butter


