RECIPES

Pickled Okra

- 1 LB whole Okra
- 1T spoon of salt
- 2 3/4 cup apple cider vinegar
- 1/2 cup sweet onions sliced thin
- 1T spoon dried dill
- 2 cloves of garlic minced
- 1 Jalapeno seeded and chopped



Combined the okra and salt in a colander, and toss. Let okra sit for 1 hour then rinse and let drain well. Meanwhile, combined onion, vinegar, dill, garlic and jalapeno in a small sauce pan. Heat on high until boil, then simmer for few minutes. Divide the okra between jars and pour the vinegar mixture over refrigerate.

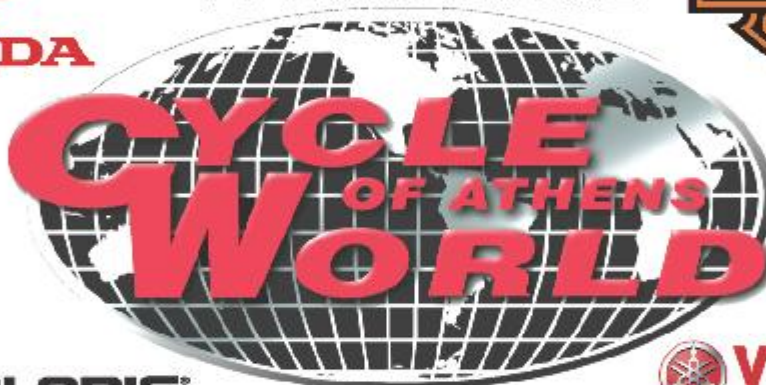
